Veteran series cases can be manufactured using heavy duty extrusions to meet the most destructive military testing. All configurations and sizes are available without tooling costs.

- Laminate Options:
 - Skins of Aluminum, Plastic, or Fiberglass.
 - Cores of Foam, High Impact ABS, Plywood, or Basswood.
- Aluminum Frame Material:
 - Tongue and groove welded aluminum extrusion.
 - Iridite process for protective coating.

- Latches/Clamps: Butterfly or adjustable-tension, Zinc or Stainless.
